Exhibit tags are available at the Watertown Area Chamber of Commerce, located at 1 E. Kemp Avenue in Watertown, or at the Codington County Extension office, located at 1910 West Kemp Avenue.

Two drop off times for 2017 Home & Family Contest entries have been set at the Park & Rec Fieldhouse: Friday (February 3, 2017) from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and Monday (February 6, 2017) from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Winners in each category will be notified by phone and scheduled for a photo to be submitted to local media.

This year's Home & Family programming will also see some exciting changes, with the addition of hands-on classes offered each day of the 2017 Watertown Winter Farm Show. Check out the complete schedule on pages 4 and 5.

2017 Home & Family Exhibits

PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

- Entries must be made FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 3 between 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. or MONDAY, FEBRUARY 6 between 8:30 - 10:30 a.m. at the Park & Rec Fieldhouse at 1900 West Kemp Ave. Exhibits will not be accepted after judging has started.
- Entries must be made in the name of the person doing the work and should not have been exhibited at previous Watertown Winter Farm Shows. Entries are open to men, women and children.
- Contestants may enter up to three exhibits in each category
- One top prize of \$50 Watertown Bucks will be awarded in each of the four categories: Adult Photography, Junior Photograph, Adult Quilts and Junior Quilts.
- Release time 3:00 - 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 11. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- The committee is not responsible for breakage, loss of item, or unclaimed items after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 11. You are encouraged to make arrangements to have someone pick up your exhibits.
- Junior Department is for persons ages 18 and younger. **Youth may not enter exhibits in adult lots.**
- Persons who own and operate a business or receive remuneration for their work are not eligible to exhibit and are considered professionals. Individuals who have received an advanced degree or training in a specific area and are currently employed in that area are also ineligible to participate.
- Quilts: Any size quilt, hand or machine quilted.
- Photography: 8" x 10" mounted on core foam (10" x 14" or 11" x 14" in size – any color may be used). Photo can be color or black and white. Include label on back of core foam which includes name of exhibitor and camera type. It is recommended to use rubber cement for the mounting of photos.
- All exhibits should be clean, free of dust and stains.
- Exhibit tags must be attached to each exhibit entered. The exhibit tags are available at:
