



FARM SAFETY POSTER CONTEST

2026 WATERTOWN WINTER FARM SHOW
FEBRUARY 11-14, 2026

The Watertown Winter Farm Show will be hosting a Farm Safety Poster Contest, sponsored by Farm Credit Services of America. The poster should illustrate an aspect of farm safety. Posters may be created with any form of media including crayons, colored pencils or markers. Only one entry per child may be submitted and posters should be on an 11x17 or 12x18 inch paper.

There are three age categories

- 5 to 7 years of age
- 8 to 10 years of age
- 11 to 13 years of age

In the lower right-hand corner of the poster, please include name, age, and school. On the back of the poster, please include parent/guardian name, phone number and mailing address.

Posters will be judged using the following criteria: attracts attention, conveys message, originality, and workmanship. Submit to the Codington County Extension Office, 1910 West Kemp Ave. Watertown, SD 57201 by Thursday, January 15, 2026. Entries will be judged prior to the Watertown Winter Farm Show and, as space allows, will be on display throughout the event.

First, second, and third place awards will be given in each category, provided by Farm Credit Services of America. Winners will be notified and awards will be given at 11:30AM, Saturday, February 14, 2026 in the Extension Complex Classrooms during an Awards Presentation.
