CROP SHOW JUDGING TO TAKE PLACE AT THE CODINGTON COUNTY EXTENSION COMPLEX

ENTRY RULES:

- 1. No entry fees will be charged.
- 2. Entries from any county will be accepted, but \$1,000 donation must be awarded to a South Dakota Agricultural organization.
- 3. An exhibitor may have multiple entries.
- 4. All exhibitors must conform to the amount specified. Smaller exhibits will be displayed but will not be eligible for awards.
- 5. Every exhibit must be properly labeled with exhibitor name, organization, address, county and lot entry.
- 6. All entries shipped must be received by Thursday, February 1, 2024. Entries should be shipped to the below address. Allow sufficient delivery time for mailed shipments.

- 7. Exhibits personally delivered to the show must be entered by 12:00 Noon, Friday, February 2, 2024.
- 8. Exhibits will be disposed of by Noon on Saturday, February 10th and will not be returned. If you want your sample saved, you must advise staff upon check-in and entries must be picked up between Noon and 3:00pm on Saturday, February 10, 2024.
- 9. Awards will be presented to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in the following divisions: Row Crops, Small Grains, Forage, Other Crops and Hay.
- 10. Each entry made will be eligible for a prize drawing of a \$1,000 donation, made by the SD Crop Improvement Association in the contestant's name, to a South Dakota 4-H Club or FFA Chapter of their choice.
- 11. The Agricultural club or organization with the most entries exhibited will receive \$200 and second place will receive \$100.
